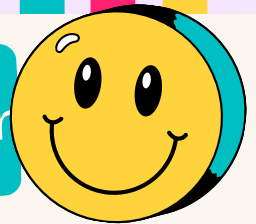

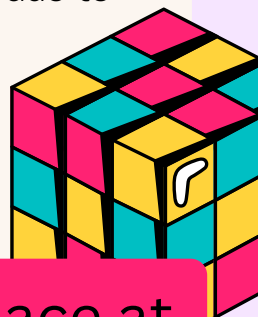
Welcome to you new look newsletter



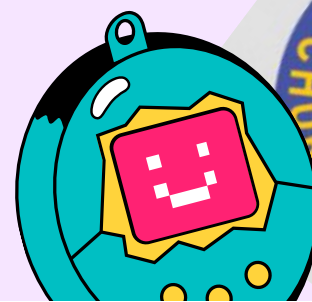

READING REMINDER:

REGULARLY READING WITH YOUR CHILD IS ESSENTIAL FOR THEIR LITERACY PROGRESS. NOT ONLY IS READING AN ESSENTIAL SKILL IN ITSELF, BUT IT HAS A KNOCK ON EFFECT, BUILDING VOCABULARY AND FEEDING IMAGINATION. CHILDREN WHO READ FOR PLEASURE DO BETTER IN A WIDE RANGE OF SUBJECTS AT SCHOOL. CHILDREN IN CLASSES 1 & 2 SHOULD BE READING REGULARLY, MOST EVENINGS, SHARING A BOOK WITH AN ADULT, WHILE CHILDREN IN CLASS 3 SHOULD STILL BE READING AT LEAST 3 TIMES A WEEK. FAMILIES WHO ENJOY READING TOGETHER HAVE MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR DISCUSSION, DEVELOPING EMPATHY AND ATTACHMENT.
